Terms and Conditions

The Healthy Baby Fair originated as a preventive health initiative of the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program. This year the event continues with the mission to target expectant parents and families with children through age 5 years. Families gain information about maternal, child, and family health, wellness, safety, and consumer education – including information about related programs, services, and businesses - through interactive displays and hands-on activities.

Basic Requirements

- (1) Exhibit space will have a display and activity (product demonstration, interactive exercise, drawing, or sample).
- (2) Exhibit will be staffed for all event hours.
- (3) All exhibit spaces will be set up on Friday, October 21, 2011, between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Alternate arrangements may be considered.
- (4) Exhibit signage with organization name is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- (5) Exhibit space will include an exhibit table, cover/skirt, and 2 chairs.

Exhibitor's Responsibilities

Each Exhibitor is responsible for payment of labor, equipment, and services (other than items in Standard Package), which are listed on the John S. Knight Center web page (<http://www.johnsknightcenter.org/DefaultJSK.aspx?PageL2Id=6>). Exhibitor acknowledges that the **Healthy Baby Fair & Family Expo** does not maintain insurance covering damages, destruction, or loss of Exhibitor's property; and, Summit County Health District and its community partners assume no responsibility for loss or damage to the Exhibitor's property.
